



Basilique Notre-Dame de Montréal

As part of Phase II of the reconstruction of Place d'Armes, please note that, starting May 1st and continuing until September 15th 2010, Notre-Dame Street eastbound, between St-François-Xavier and St-Sulpice streets will be closed to all automotive traffic.

Consequently, all processions will need to use Côte de la Place d'Armes, follow Place d'Armes Street and continue on St-Sulpice Street. People may get out at the corner of St-Sulpice and Notre-Dame and take the stairs on the eastern side of the parvis to access the Basilica. The City will reserve five (5) parking spaces at all times for processions from the corner of Notre-Dame Street to St-Sulpice.

The first five spaces are reserved for the procession for marriages taking place in the Basilica.

Wedding processions (maximum of 4 cars) for marriages taking place in the Notre-Dame du Sacré-Coeur Chapel must park in front of 426 St-Sulpice.
